WHAT IS IT: Weekend events in connection with the **2018 Azalea and Spring Flower Trail**. A chance to work with your friends to promote Tyler, greet tourists & pose for photographs in front of scenic azalea bushes in the historic brick street district wearing antebellum dresses.

WHO CAN APPLY: Freshman and sophomore girls attending school in Smith County or Home School girls who will be available for the event times mentioned and would enjoy working with visitors to Tyler. You must be academically eligible because there will possibly be one event during school hours, unless you're out for Spring Break the week of the opening ceremony, which is scheduled for Friday, March 16th at 10am. There are also a couple of other times you will be required to attend, in preparation of the event, which will be the orientation & dress fittings.

GENERAL INFORMATION: Visit Tyler/Tyler Chamber of Commerce has a collection of long antebellum style dresses (like Scarlet wore) and hoop petticoats. If selected, you will be fitted in a particular dress to wear throughout the event. You will be responsible for returning the dress and all accessories after the event is over. You will be assigned a particular house each weekend of the trail. There are thousands of people who come to Tyler to see these beautiful flowers and the Azalea Belles are a lovely addition to all the photos the tourists enjoy taking! Two or three girls will be assigned to each house so that no one will be alone at any location. A typical schedule involves working 3½ hours on Saturday (morning or afternoon shifts available) and Sunday afternoons for the weekends during the Festival. You will only be allowed two shift conflicts for appearances at the homes during the 3 weekends of the Trail. The 2018 Festival is scheduled for March 16–April 1 (EASTER Sunday is April 1st, so no one will work that day). The only cost involved in being an Azalea Belle is the cost of the white satin gloves (\$25). These will be yours to keep. All other supplies are provided by Visit Tyler.

WHAT TO DO: Get an application from your counselor or you can access it online at www.visitt Tyler.com/azaleatrail. You may complete it and bring by or mail it to the Chamber of Commerce, no later than **5pm, Wednesday, January 17th**. **No late applications will be accepted!** Please mail or return in person to:

Once your application has been turned in, please make arrangements to attend an interview session. YOU must call Susan Travis at 903-592-6978 to set up a day and time for your interview. The days available are: Monday thru Wednesday, January 22-24, between 2pm & 5pm at the Chamber of Commerce/Visit Tyler offices, located at 315 N. Broadway. Those selected will be notified by letter by Friday, Feb. 2nd. If selected, it is necessary that you are available for an orientation meeting on Tuesday, February 6th from 4:30-6pm, dress fittings will be Tuesday-Thursday, February 13-15 (you will only have to come one of those days), as well as the morning of Friday, March 16th for the Opening Ceremony and each weekend of the Trail (March 16-March 31. We will not work on Easter Sunday, April 1st). By your signature, you agree that you will make yourself available to the Visit Tyler/Tyler Chamber of Commerce on these dates. A complete list of dates and other information will be sent with each girl's letter of acceptance.
